

PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE CLOSURE AND CONSOLIDATION OF SCHOOLS IN THE ATLANTA PUBLIC SCHOOLS DISTRICT

Atlanta Public Schools invites the community to public hearings about the restructuring of non-traditional programs to create one new comprehensive alternative school. The proposal contemplates a new design that includes the performance learning center model, virtual learning and other recovery/acceleration programs.

Non-Traditional Public Hearings will address the following possible scenarios:

1) Close Alonzo A. Crim Open Campus High School and Reconstitute West End Academy; Delay Relocation

- 2019-2020 school year a new comprehensive alternative school would open on the current Crim campus for grades 9-12 with a projected enrollment of 358 students
- 2020-2021 school year the new comprehensive alternative school would be relocated to a surplus building such as the current Tuskegee Airmen Global Academy
- There is currently no estimated renovation cost since the district is still identifying the ideal surplus building

2) Close Alonzo A. Crim Open Campus High School and reconstitute West End Academy; Relocation

- 2019-2020 school year a new comprehensive alternative school would open in a surplus building such as the current Tuskegee Airmen Global Academy for grades 9-12 with a projected enrollment of 358 students
- There is currently no estimated renovation cost since the district is still identifying the ideal surplus building
- The district is still considering options for use of the Crim campus

3) Close Alonzo A. Crim Open Campus High School and Reconstitute West End Academy; No Relocation

- 2019-2020 school year non-traditional programs would remain the same; appointed school leadership would plan for the launch of the new comprehensive alternative school to open 2020-2021
- 2020-2021 school year the new comprehensive alternative school would open on the current Crim campus for grades 9-12 with a projected enrollment of 358 students
- The Crim campus has the capacity to handle both schools with no expected renovation cost
